The seafood used in our products is sourced from overseas suppliers. Therefore, we do not source raw ingredients from Fukushima or its neighboring prefectures. We have always used water from an underground spring located within the factory premises during our manufacturing processes; hence, we began to monitor our water supply before reopening the factory to confirm its safety when the problem of nuclear substances occurred.
